We take your privacy seriously and appreciate your interest in us. When you visit our site and communicate with us via our site, we will not collect personal information about you unless you provide us that information voluntarily. Any non-public personal information that you may provide via our site will be used solely for the purpose stated on the page where it is collected. Synfurn will not sell, license, transmit or disclose this information outside of Synfurn unless (a) expressly authorized by you, (b) necessary to enable Synfurn contractors or agents to perform certain functions for us, or (c) required or permitted by law. In all cases, we will disclose the information consistent with applicable laws and regulations and we will require the recipient to protect the information and use it only for the purpose it was provided. By "personal information," we refer to data that is unique to an individual, such as a name, address, e-mail address, or telephone number. From time to time, we may request personal information from you at our site to enable delivery of requested materials to you, respond to your questions, or deliver a product or service.
